# Inerrancy Matters

- ▣ **Deductive Reasoning**
- ▣ **Major Premise:** God always speaks the truth and cannot lie (Romans 3:4; I John 1:5–7).
- ▣ **Minor Premise:** The entire Bible was spoken by God (2 Timothy 3:16–17; 2 Peter 1:20–21).
- ▣ **Conclusion:** The Bible is true.
